SPELLINGS

The children undertake daily spelling sessions using our Jungle Club spelling scheme. Although the children don't bring home weekly spellings to learn, please check our Year Group Blog each week to see the spelling rules, grammatical skills and homophone spellings each week to practise at home.

WRITING

As the children become more independent in their writing, we love to see what they create at home stories, poems, playscripts, anything creative - we love to share!

Handwriting continues to be a big focus for us in Year 2, we are continuing to encourage the cursive script and we would ask that you continue to encourage your children to practise this at home too so that they can apply it to their independent writing at school.
