




Cook's Endeavour to Australia




Cook left on HMS Endeavour in August 1768 from the UK.

What did Cook experience in Australia?




They originally lived in Australia before the colonisation of Australia by Cook.

They still live in Australia to this day.

There were very few aboriginals in Australia when Cook landed, a lot of the land was full of wild animals and plants.

What did Cook do and how has life changed in Australia?



Cook and his crew sailed back to the UK. Years later, the UK sent thousands of people to live in Australia. The start of the British Empire.

Thousands of UK people lived in Australia and built towns and cities. These cities got bigger as more people lived there.

In 1769, there were a few thousand people living in Australia. Now, there are over 26 million people living in Australia in over 540 cities.
