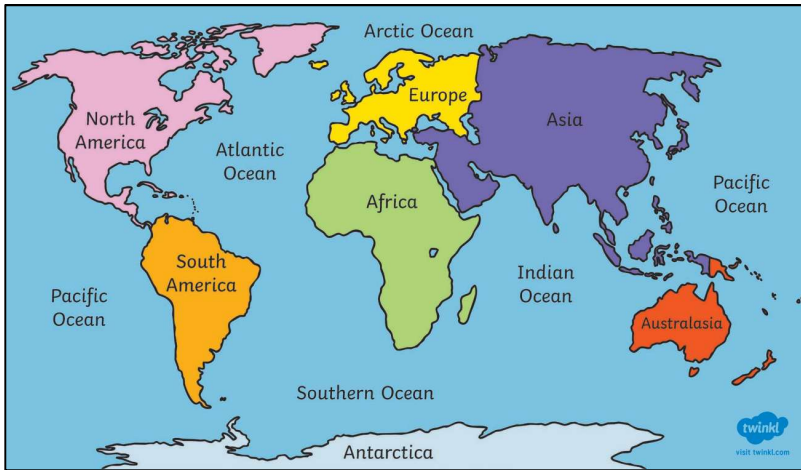


**Oceans and seas around the UK**

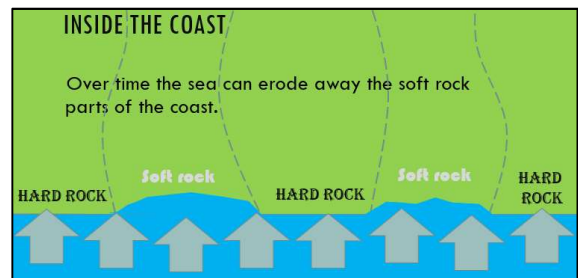


**Features of coastlines**

<b>Cliffs</b>	→		→		→	A steep rock face, normally at the edge of the sea/ocean.
<b>Caves</b>	→		→		→	A natural underground chamber in a cliff or hill.
<b>Beaches</b>	→		→		→	Area covered by sand at the edge of a body of water.
<b>Tide/Wave</b>	→		→		→	Tide: The rise and fall of the sea. Wave: Water that curls into an arch and breaks on the shore.

**Coastal Erosion**

The process where earth is worn away by wind or water. Soft rock is worn away quicker than hard rock to form different features.



**Human impact on coastlines**

Humans aim to slow the rate of coastal erosion, to stop homes and land being lost.
