



The Earth spins once a day.


**BUT**

It starts to get lighter. Plants grow. Animals are born.


Animals come out of hibernation Sunny, windy, rainy, wet.

Daylight hours are longer.


Trees have lots of leaves. Sunny, hot, cloudy, stormy.
