**Buckden Towers a significant historical place.**



Built in 1175

It was known as a palace.

Home to the Bishop's of Lincoln.



Big fire in 1291 destroyed most of the buildings and only the foundations remained.



Katherine of Aragon was held here after her divorce from Henry VIII.

Katherine of Aragon was held there between 1533 – 1534.



The original buildings were replaced by brick constructions in 1472.

The great tower was built in 1475.



After World War II the estate was donated to the church.



Today it is a tourist destination for people to see where Katherine of Aragon was held.
