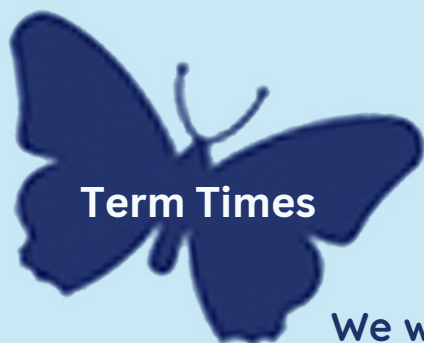

We had a fantastic amount of research done on endangered animals which children completed at home. Miss Harris received a large number of posters from children, which were all displayed in our celebration assembly.

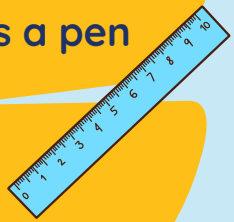

Arbor

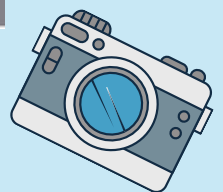
Over the half term break make sure you child's Arbor profile is up to date with emergency contact details/dietary requirements and medical conditions.
