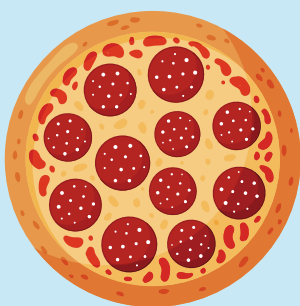
It was lovely to see parents enjoying

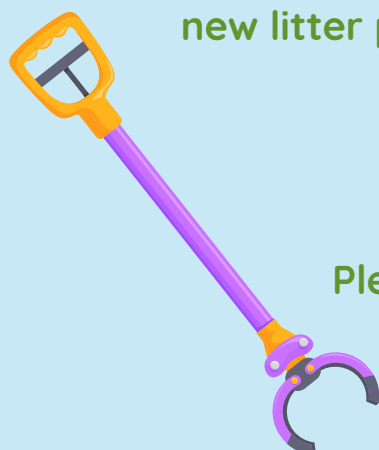


You may notice on the new menu that

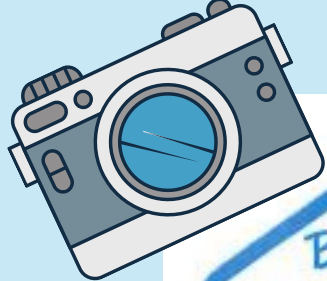
